See Callahan memorandum of November 30th re Safe Haven Project. Work on this project requires careful planning as it might defeat direct intelligence activities and close important channels for German work if believed this one of our main objectives. Today we must fish in troubled waters and maintain contacts with persons suspected of working with Nazis on such matters. For example, see question H of attached memorandum which relates to our 496. Both 496 and X-2 here can be useful under cover but believe idea of working practically as agents of Commercial Attache and Consul General, Zurich, on this project would be unwise. Further, to deal effectively with matter, it would require special staff with new covers. Possibly Macaraki would have special qualifications to develop organization for this work. At present we do not have adequate personnel to do effective job in this field and meet other demands.
