



## Remembering Rwanda 1994-2004

This is one of a series of events commemorating the 10th anniversary of the Rwandan Genocide. Between April and July 1994, the Rwandan genocide saw the slaughter of close to one million Rwandan men, women and children and the exodus of hundreds of thousands more to neighboring countries. The “Remembering Rwanda” commemoration has been organized both to remember the victims and the survivors of this horrific event, and to generate a public conversation about the failure to prevent the Rwanda genocide and the lessons that can be learned from that failure.
